

## **Camp Safety**

1. Please remove all vehicles from your campsite after unloading and park in the designated parking areas
2. Never allow Scouts to ride in the back of pick-up trucks.
3. Speed Limit is 15 mph maximum, 5 mph when Scouts are present.
4. Please do not bring bicycles, skateboards, or roller blades (and similar devices) to camp.
5. No Alcoholic Beverages or Illegal Drugs are allowed on Camp Property.
6. No dogs or pets allowed in the camp (not even on a leash). Handicap needs - please register with staff.
7. Shower house: Only boys use the "Boys" area. There is no code for entry. Adults (male and female) and adult supervised female youth use the "Adult" bathrooms.
8. Fishing is allowed along the shoreline of the lake. All fishing regulations of the state of Georgia apply. NO FISHING in the area within the fence perimeter of the swim area.
9. When disposing of garbage and trash please use the dumpsters behind the dining hall.
10. Campfires are limited to the permanent fire ring only. No temporary fire rings are to be constructed. No flame is to ever be left unattended.
11. Use the Buddy System and always tell an adult where you are going.
12. No running in camp.
13. If you get lost:
  - a. Stop and try to figure out where you are. Don't wander.
  - b. Use your head, not your legs.
  - c. Be visible / stay in the open
  - d. Use a whistle or yell.
  - e. Don't run, don't worry, and above all, don't quit.
